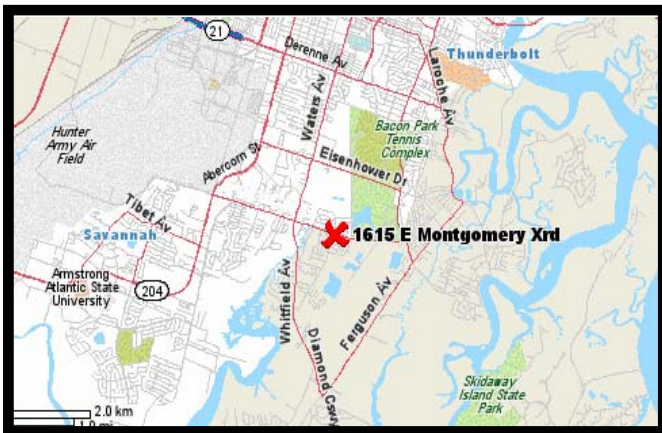


## Fees and Insurance

As a courtesy to our patients, we file insurance for medical services provided. All co-pays and deductibles are to be paid at the time services are rendered. Routine vision exams and refractions are generally not covered by most insurance carriers and are payable at the time of the visit. Some insurance plans require a referral prior to being seen by a specialist. Please obtain any necessary referrals prior to your visit. If you are unsure if you need a referral contact your insurance carrier. Failure to do so may delay our ability to see you and, on occasion, may cause insurance carriers to deny payment for your treatment. Please keep us informed as to any changes in insurance coverage, mailing addresses, etc. We understand financial problems sometimes arise, and if there is a problem with making a payment, please contact our financial department so we may make special arrangements for payments on your account. If you have any questions regarding fees or insurance, we will be glad to discuss them, but we need to do so prior to care being given. We will gladly see you if you do not have insurance, but we require payment at the time of service.

### We Look Forward to Your Appointment

All of Boland Eye Center's exams are scheduled by appointment. We ask that you arrive on time when possible and that you let us know when you cannot be here at the scheduled time. If you are more than 15 minutes late we will still attempt to see you, but sometimes it will be necessary to reschedule. Everyone detests doctors' offices that overbook and make everyone wait. We therefore have a policy of never overbooking patients. In return, we ask that if you know that you will be unable to meet an appointment you call us at least 24 hours in advance so we can fill your time slot with another patient.

We know that paperwork is an irritant, but you will probably be asked to complete some paperwork on most visits. Please be patient with us as we try to process your visit accurately. It is imperative that you bring a record of all medications you are currently taking as well as your current glasses. If you use contacts please wear them to your appointment. Because eyes are constantly changing, all of our contact lens wearers need to see Dr. Holmes for exams and fittings to ensure that their prescriptions are still correct. Be cognizant of the fact that there are additional fees for contact lens fittings. Make sure to ask for any extra information you need.

Our office hours are 8am to 5pm Monday through Friday and Saturdays from 8:30am to 3:00pm. To help our working patients, we have extended hours on Tuesdays to meet with Dr. Holmes. We will always try to be as flexible with our schedule as we can. Our aim, after all, is to help you.

Call our office anytime during regular business hours to schedule your appointment. We try to return non-urgent calls (such as questions or prescription refills) placed in the morning by noon and non-urgent calls made after noon by 5pm. We are seeing patients throughout the day and must screen calls to accommodate all our patients. After hours calls are important to us too, and they are handled by our answering service. Your call will be returned by one of our Doctors or the physician on city call as quickly as possible.

Please be aware that all of our exams take at least 60 minutes. If we dilate you, as we do for most exams, the visit will take at least 90 minutes. Dilation does not work the same on all patients, and some eyes may take longer to dilate than others, thereby lengthening the visit. Also, because we see emergency patients throughout the day, many with sight-threatening problems, we may occasionally experience a delay which slows us down. We apologize and ask for your patience when that happens.
